I was lucky enough to join an Historical Textiles tour with the Centre for Textile Research based at Copenhagen University. We visited several social enterprises/NGOs working to revitalise traditional crafts such as weaving and silkworm farms. We had a go at dyeing with mango leaves; basket weaving using water hyacinth reeds, and extracting fibre from lotus stalks – as well as enjoying fantastic food and all the usual sights.
