Once again the year is filling up with exciting opportunities. Mary and I have been teaching a new workshop based on the 'Fabric Hug' which is a really lovely and emotive session, creating artwork from old photos and surrounding the photos with favourite fabrics. We have taught this to small groups, individuals and larger stitch groups – if your group would be interested in this workshop please get in touch.

The original 'fabric hug' developed from a photograph I took on a visit to the Khmer Rouge torture prison in Cambodia last year. The walls are lined with photographs of those who were tortured and killed, and this girl's photograph struck me as so beautiful that when I got home I wanted to bring her back to life with some colour so I surrounded her with gorgeous fabrics.





A group of artists from the Living from Art group have had our work hung on the walls of Ashlea Financial Services in Cheltenham for the past 3 months. The group are very supportive of local artists and combine this with fundraising for local charities. In February they held a coffee/cake morning in aid of Cheltenham Samaritans and Cheltenham Open Door which was a lovely opportunity for us to meet their customers and help support these causes.

## **Natural Dyeing**



I have started off some seedlings to grow this year's crop of natural dye plants.

Here are the Weld and Dyers Camomile just coming through. Sadly my Woad seeds didn't germinate.





But I have a healthy Genista in the garden.

And some dried Dyers Camomile and Genista from last year yet to be used.



I've also been experimenting with mixed media/collage – following a workshop with the lovely Helen Norman at Cheltenham Art Club.
